

# Arriva

Arriva Trains Wales operates a mix of long distance, regional and local rural services in Wales, including the Valley Lines network of services around Cardiff, and also in the English border counties and to Manchester, Liverpool and Birmingham.

## Onboard services

### - Premier Class

- Service available on Holyhead-Cardiff route. The service leaves Holyhead at 0532 arriving at Bangor half an hour later at 0602. The journey from Bangor to Cardiff Central takes just under four hours – arriving at 0958. The evening service leaves Cardiff at 1617 arriving Holyhead 2049.
- Complementary cooked breakfast on the morning service and a three course meal on the north bound service in the evening.
- Reservations are recommended southbound and are mandatory northbound
- There are no power points for mobile phones or laptops on these services



### - Standard Class

- Hot and cold snacks will be available for purchase from the buffet for standard class passengers.

**Cycles** are carried free of charge. However, space can be limited, and there are restrictions on carrying cycles on busy high speed and commuter services. Valleys and Cardiff local routes bicycles cannot be taken on trains during peak hours. On peak services to/from London Paddington, cycle reservations are essential.
